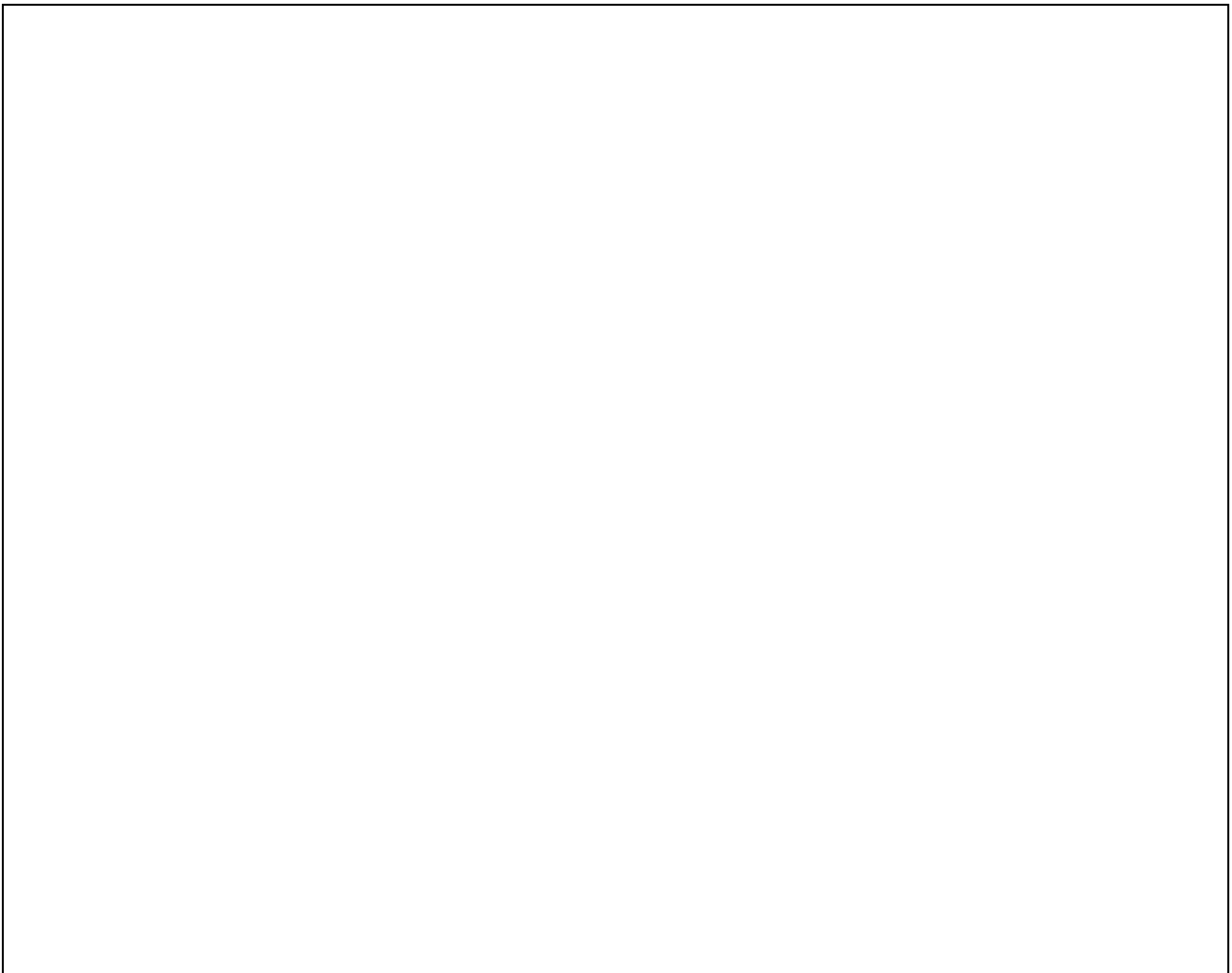

### While Shepherds Watched Their Flocks

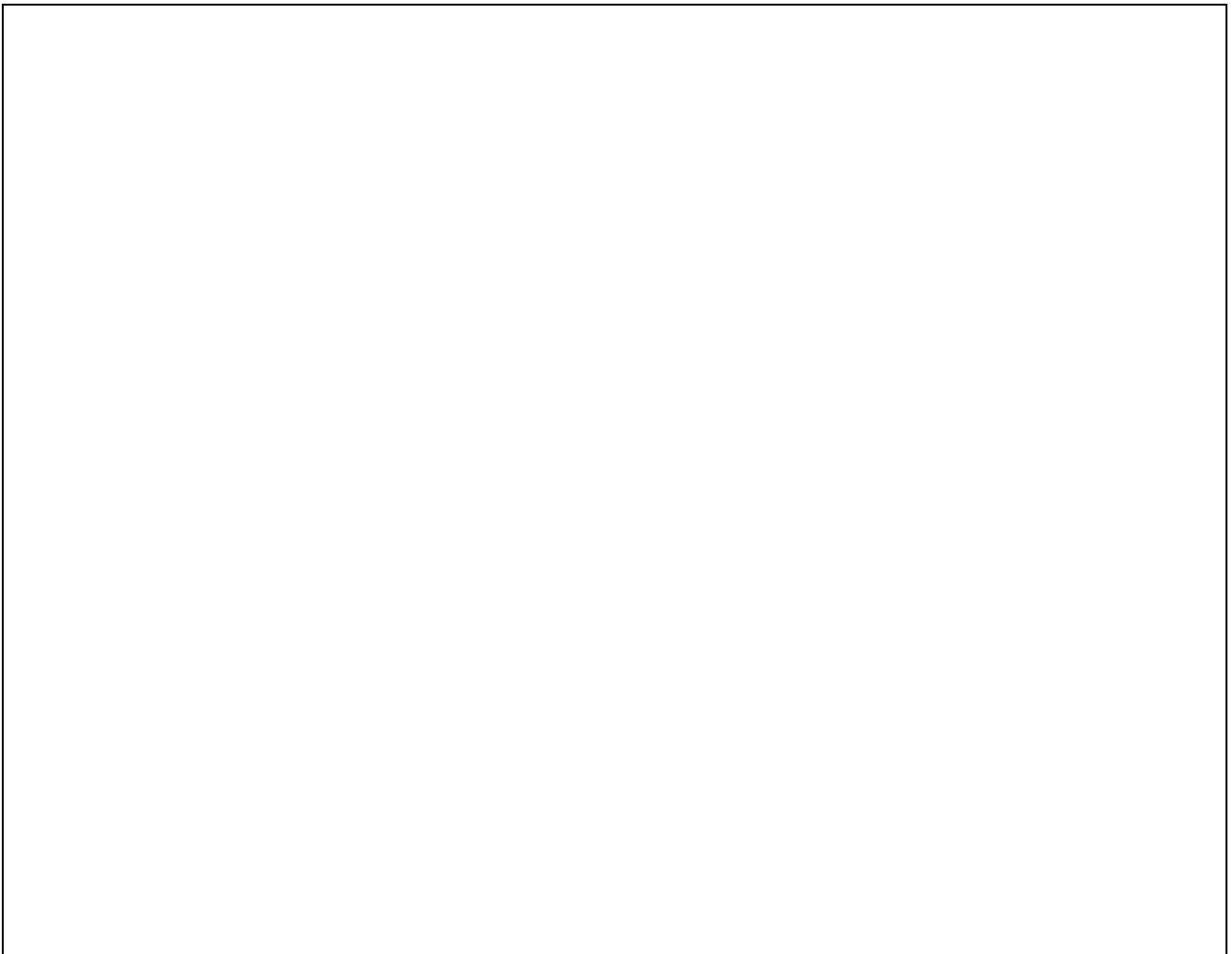
Here are the words to the carol. You can draw your own picture to go with the words using the paintings to help you.

And glory shone around.




### Hidden Meanings

In this gallery are many paintings of Mary and baby Jesus. Sometimes the baby Jesus is holding things in his hands, sometimes wearing things around his neck and head. All these objects have special meanings. Try to match the objects (symbols) to their special meanings. We have done one for you.

SYMBOL	MEANING
Goldfinch	Inspired by Adam and Eve - a sign of sins that could be forgiven by Jesus
Coral	Reminds us of crucifixion - this creature plucked out a thorn from Jesus' head on his way to the cross
Laurel leaves	Betrothal - or being engaged to the church
Apple	Hung around a baby's neck for protection
Carnation	The sign of a holy person
Halo	A sign of virtue
