
jects from Home: A Kazakh Hat (Saukele)



Saukele is a part of a traditional Kazakh bridal costume. My great-grandmother wore this hat on her wedding in 1920 and then passed it on to my grandmother, who gave it to me as a present on my 18<sup>th</sup> birthday.

The most popular colours of saukele are white, yellow and blue. It is always embroidered with traditional Kazakh patterns and pieces of jewelry. The top of the hat is filled with a bird's feathers, while the strip at the bottom was usually made of the fur of a fox.






### HE FITZWILLIAM MUSEUM: IRANIAN BOWL



This Iranian bowl dates back to 12 – 1 century and is coated in a white glaze painted in polychrome which involves blue, red, green, black and brown colours. The bowl is carinated and has slightly everted, collared neck. Three horsemen in the centre of the bowl w bows and arrows reminded me of Kazakh nomads because bow and arro were main weapons in hunting and w in the nomadic world.
