Herakles and Kyklos

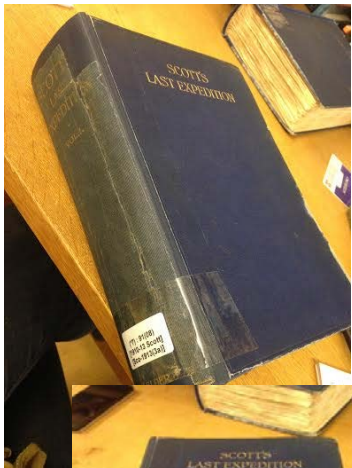


Eye-cup: Herakles and Kyklos

Fired clay, black-figure technique.

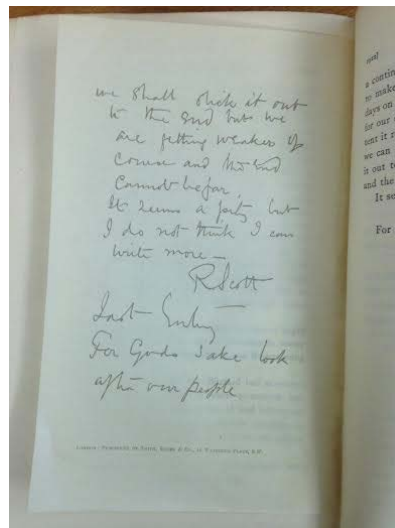

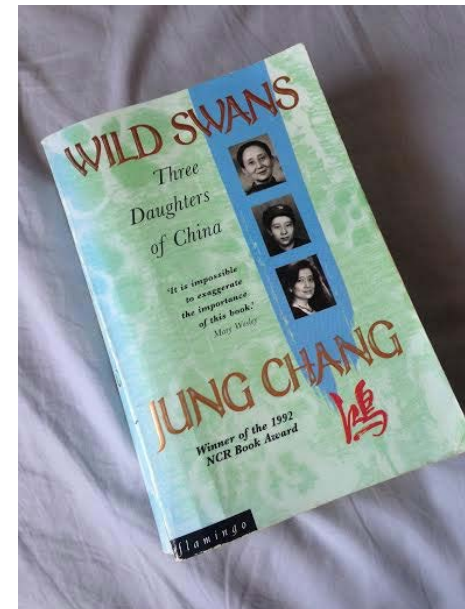
